COURSE DESCRIPTION: This is an instructor level course. It requires each student to present assigned topics throughout the week to the class and team-teach an assigned topic to a group of students as part of the course's final exam. The instructional "final exam" is a 60-minute practical application presentation. Presentation topics and team assignments will be given out on the first day of class. Students are also required to take and pass a written final exam.

COURSE INSTRUCTORS: This course is taught by a team of instructors who are highly skilled and experienced in the tactical deployment of chemical agents. The cadre has decades of special operations experience from which to share administrative and operational issues that impact law enforcement's use of chemical agents.

STUDENTS MUST:

- Bring either a laptop and/or iPad/Tablet to complete the written components to the 60-minute practical application presentation.
- Munitions: 2 Ferrets and 2 Hand-held Chemical Agent Munitions
- A 37mm/40mm Chemical Agent Launcher
- Gas Mask/Air Purifying Respirator and an Extra Filter
- Hearing Protection (that can be worn with a gas mask/APR)
- Nomex Gloves
- Eye Protection
- Tactical Uniform and Boots or other Appropriate Clothing
- Calculator
